- No Concession Stand will be provided
- Restrooms will be open

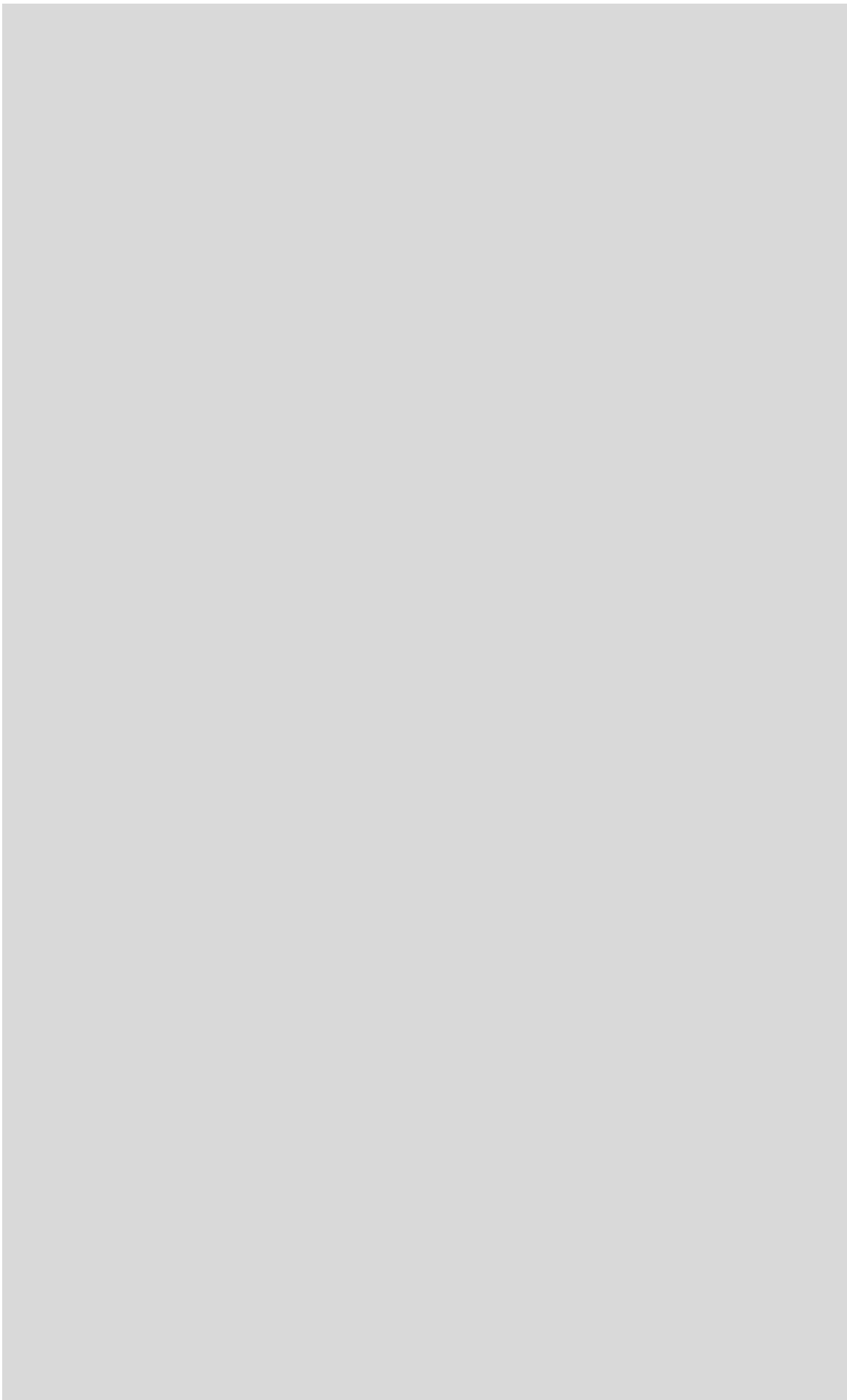
