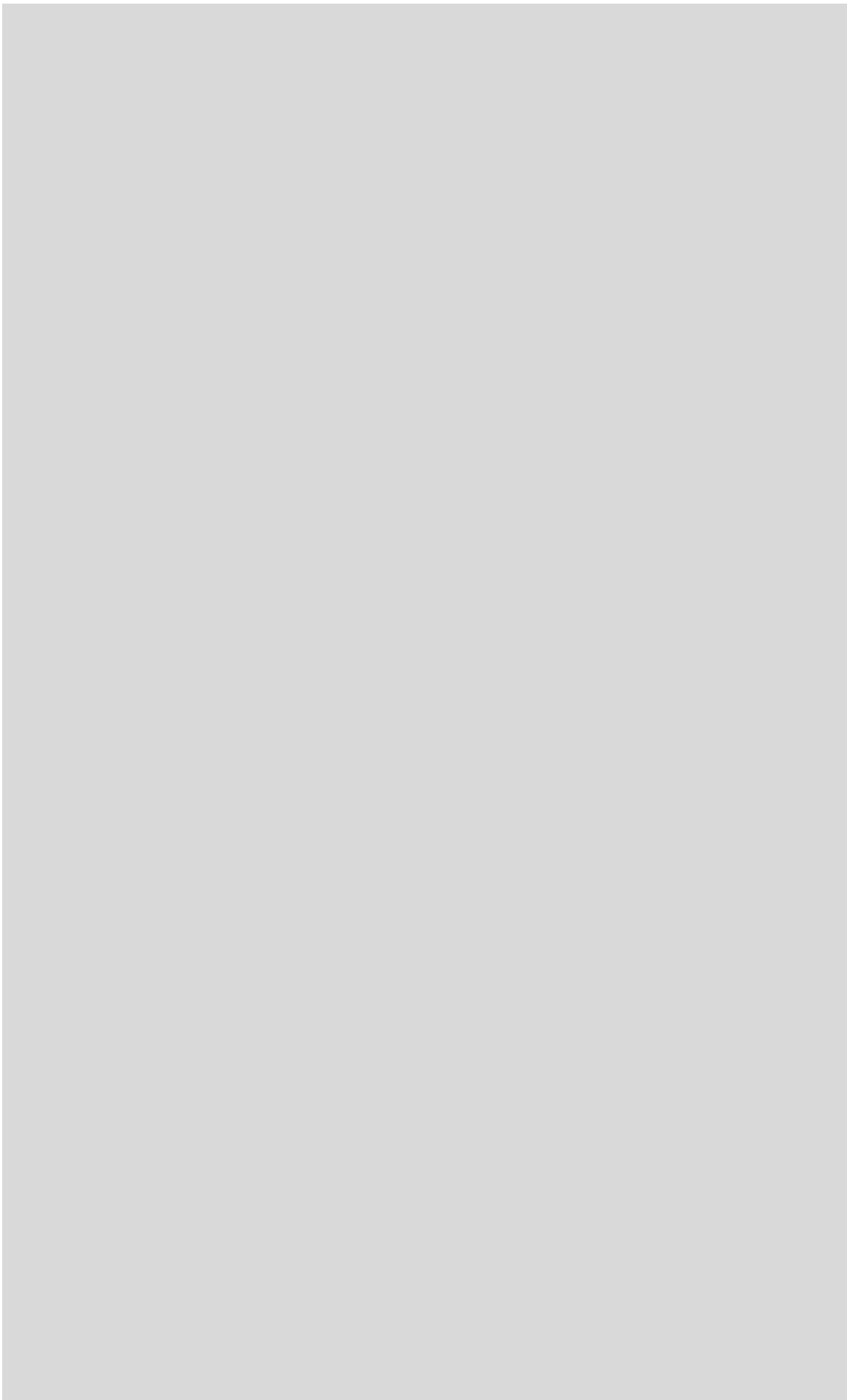
### **\*\*NEW\*\* Crossing Guards & Covid Bell Schedule Transition**

Palo Alto Police Department is working hard with the city's Crossing Guard service provider to staff all guarded elementary school route intersections at the new school commute times as quickly as possible. This will take some time. PAUSD's recent bell time changes with different bell times at different schools require a significant increase to the guard company's working schedule, and they are doing their best to staff these extra shifts as quickly as they can. The city hopes to have complete coverage by next week, assuming recruiting/training goes well. Note that the crossing guards are stationed primarily for the elementary schools, and overlap with middle and high school bell times is only coincidental, but PAPD will try to arrange a schedule that will help accommodate MS/HS over time. As always, if you notice gaps in service at normally guarded locations on your route to school, please call [329-2413](tel:329-2413) to report that the guard is absent. PAPD will work with the Guard Service to fix the problem.
