### **\*\*NEW\*\* COVID Testing for Staff and Students**

Beginning next week, PAUSD, in partnership with Predicine, Inc., will offer COVID testing for students and staff. The following testing strategy will be utilized:

- Any student, teacher, and staff with symptoms identified through the health screening protocols
- Any student, teacher, and staff who have had contact with someone with COVID-19 in the school or workplace
- All students, faculty, and staff with possible exposure in the context of outbreak settings
- Surveillance testing 2x/Month (25% of secondary students attending in-person) for individuals who are asymptomatic. Note: Surveillance testing detects the presence of COVID-19 even in individuals who may be asymptomatic.
- PAEA Unit Member Testing 2x/month
- Testing for indoor sports athletes, coaches, and support staff 2-3x week until we reach the Yellow Tier.

**IMPORTANT:** Participating in COVID testing through PAUSD/Predicine, Inc. requires participants to consent to being tested. Signing the consent form and participating in the testing program is your consent to share results of your COVID test with the District Nurse and/or the Director of Human Resources . A copy of the consent form is included for review. A printed copy will be available at your school upon request.

#### **COVID TESTING TRAINING AND Q & A**

In order to provide high quality and equitable training/resources across the diverse demographics we serve, 3 back-to-back virtual training sessions will be conducted by Predicine, in different languages. Parents may join the session conducted in their preferred language. Topics will include how to register, test requisition forms, barcode placement, nasal swab collection, packaging, and test results.

### **Crossing Guards & Covid Bell Schedule Transition**

Palo Alto Police Department is working hard with the city's Crossing Guard service provider to staff all guarded elementary school route intersections at the new school commute times as quickly as possible. This will take some time. PAUSD's recent bell time changes with different bell times at different schools require a significant increase to the guard company's working schedule, and they are doing their best to staff these extra shifts as quickly as they can. The city hopes to have complete coverage by next week, assuming recruiting/training goes well. Note that the crossing guards are stationed primarily for the elementary schools, and overlap with middle and high school bell times is only coincidental, but PAPD will try to arrange a schedule that will help accommodate MS/HS over time. As always, if you notice gaps in service at normally guarded locations on your route to school, please call [329-2413](tel:329-2413) to report that the guard is absent. PAPD will work with the Guard Service to fix the problem.
